Here are some things you can do to help develop your puppy's social skills:



Introduce new things early

New scents, environments and sounds help desensitize puppies to changes. Keep new experiences positive with plenty of treats!



Crate train

Learning to be alone can help your puppy remain calm in social situations. If you're going to crate train, start doing it from day one.



Handle your pup

Regularly touch your puppy's ears, toes, and mouth to familiarize them with the feeling of nail trims, teeth brushing, grooming and veterinary appointments.



Encourage alone time

Just like children, dogs can develop separation anxiety. Discourage an unhealthy attachment to you by giving your puppy some toys and leaving them alone to play.



Stay up to date with vaccines

If your puppy is too young to be fully vaccinated, avoid places where there are lots of dogs around, like the dog park and classes.



Sign up for puppy classes

When your puppy is fully vaccinated, check with your local rescue shelter or doggy daycare for puppy classes.



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
