## Preventive medicine helps to keep your cat healthier, prevent disease, and detect illness earlier for best treatment.

Wellness Plans assist you in helping your pet live a healthy life while you financially manage the costs associated with their care.

Our Exam and Consultations include a thorough nose to tail examination and time for discussion with the veterinarian.

Vaccinations protect against harmful and even fatal infectious diseases. Vaccines are based on the lifestyle of your cat and our plans cover the most common vaccines. Other vaccinations may be required that are not included in the plan.

Fecal tests check for the presence of internal parasites including roundworms, hookworms, tapeworms, whipworms, and Giardia.

Blood tests are essential tools for identifying diseases as early as possible, when they are most treatable. Your cat could appear healthy but still have underlying health problems.

Annual deworming is highly recommended. Since mice are an intermediate host for tapeworms, studies have shown that even indoor cats can be infected.

You can also choose to incorporate routine dental care as part of your Wellness Plan. Dental care for cats is important to their overall health. Please see our Oral Health Care Plan.
