Vaccinations protect against harmful, and even fatal, infectious diseases. Vaccines are based on the lifestyle of your dog and our plans cover the most common vaccines. Other vaccinations may be required that are not included in the plan.

Fecal tests check for the presences of internal parasites including roundworms, hookworms, tapeworms, whipworms, and Giardia.

Blood tests are essential tools for identifying diseases as early as possible, when they are most treatable. Your cat could appear healthy but still have underlying health problems.

Bi-monthly and seasonal prevention products help protect your cat from fleas, ticks, and internal parasites.
