**Preventive medicine helps to keep your dog healthier, prevent disease, and detect illness earlier for best treatment.**

The Oral Health Plan assists you in helping your pets live a healthy life while you financially manage the costs associated with their dental care.

80% of dogs and 70% of cats over three years of age have dental disease\*\*. Aside from saving your dog or cat pain and discomfort, dental health is related to more serious health conditions such as heart, kidney, and liver disease.

General anesthesia is crucial to performing a thorough dental exam and cleaning, while reducing pain and stress for your pet. For dental radiographs (x-rays), it is required your pet be very still in order to produce quality, diagnostic images, and this is impossible without anesthesia.

Your pet's teeth are carefully examined and charted by a Veterinarian. A Registered Veterinary Technician uses an ultrasonic scaler to remove plaque and tartar from each tooth above and below the gumline, and then uses a paste to polish the teeth.

Dental radiographs are performed to assess for abnormalities including tooth root abnormalities, bone loss, periodontal disease/infection, and tumors.
